# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD MEETING DATED August 13, 2018

Chairperson Mindi Schmitz called the meeting to order at 4:00pm.

Mike Soulis requested to add to the agenda under New Business G. Strategic Plan. All approved to add to the agenda.

Mark Ukestad made a motion to approve the July 9, 2018 minutes as written. Mike Soulis seconded. All approved.

Mark Ukestad made a motion to approve the Financial Report. Mike Landscoot seconded. All approved.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

**Board Development:** The board had 2 training opportunities in the last month – ND League of Cities (elected officials training) and NDRPA Commissioners Training Webinar. This was a good reminder of open meeting and open records.

**Pool Demolition:** John Shockley with Ohnstad Twichell Attorneys sent a Memorandum summarizing financing pool demolition. Demolition is scheduled to begin this week and be completed September 15<sup>th</sup>. John Shockely joined meeting via conference call to discuss options. They recommend certificate of indebtedness at Unison Bank. John spoke with Unison Bank and they are ok with the terms: 1. \$182,000 (amount to be confirmed) 2. Repayment 5 years – no penalty for early payoff 3. Payable from funds received from state and any excess property taxes or other available funds 4. Tax-exempt 5. Interest rate between 4% and 4.5%. Ohnstad Twichell will prepare all documents (fee will be \$1500).

Mike Soulis motioned to authorize Ohnstad Twichell (John Shockley) to proceed with recommendation of certificate of indebtedness with Unison Bank and give Doug Hogan/Bonnie Ukestad authority to sign necessary documents. Mark Ukestad seconded. All approved.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

**Meeting Protocol:** Agenda items should be to Doug by Wednesday prior to board meeting. Discussion on how meeting packets are distributed; email vs. mailing. After much discussion all members could not come to a consensus - will discuss at a future meeting.

**Board Development:** NDRPA Conference Schedule was included in packet for anyone interested in attending - September 11-13 in Dickinson.

Outstanding Ice Time Bills: Two groups have outstanding bills for ice time; \$7,157.50 & \$630.00. They are disputing paying zamboni time. Currently when a groug is scheduled to be on the ice for an hour they are billed for their hour of ice time plus 10 minutes for zamboni time. Both groups had paid ice time through February with no issues. Billings for March & April are unpaid (Figure skaters \$7,157.50 and Pure Hockey \$630.00). Discussion on zamboni time and how to collect outstanding amounts. Mike Soulis motioned for Doug Hogan & Junior Kautz to

meet with groups to agree to a payment plan before any ice time is scheduled. Mike Landscoot seconded. All approved.

2018-19 Ice Rental Rates: Current rates are \$55 per hour for months Nov-Feb and \$70 per hour for Sept-Oct and Mar-Apr. After much discussion of different rates, Ron Olson motioned \$73 per hour for all months - \$73 includes zamboni time. Mark Ukestad seconded. All approved.

Aflac for Part-time employees: Currently we offer Aflac for Full-time benefitted employees only. Discussed whether to include part-time employees if it would help recruit and retain employees. Board would like more information so we will invite Tonya Samuelson (our Aflac representative) to attend the next board meeting.

Shared Parking Agreement with FCCU: First Community Credit Union (FCCU) is remodeling and they want to have a parking agreement. FCCU would like to use Jack Brown Stadium parking as overflow parking during the week. We will communicate to FCCU if we are having a tourney. We will have access to FCCU parking lot on the weekends. Mike Soulis motioned to approve the shared parking agreement presented. Mike Landscoot seconded. All approved.

Strategic Plan: Mike Soulis would like to see a strategic plan. Have someone to come in and do a facility audit and prioritize.
